TRANSITIONAL MS - Admission to the program requires a bachelor's degree from an accredited college/university. Students admitted to the Transitional Master's program must show evidence of having completed a minimum of one undergraduate course in each of the following content areas prior to fall quarter of their second year in the program: biological sciences (such as biology, human anatomy, etc.), physical sciences (physics or chemistry required), statistics, and the social/behavioral sciences (such as psychology, sociology, educational psychology, etc.).

<u>COMMUNICATION SCIENCES & DISORDERS MS</u> - Admission to the program requires a bachelor's degree in Communication Disorders (also called Speech-Language Pathology). \*\*Note: students admitted to the graduate program must show evidence of having completed a minimum of one undergraduate course in each of the following content areas: biological sciences (such as biology, human anatomy, etc.), physical sciences (physics or chemistry required), statistics, and the social/behavioral sciences (such as psychology, sociology, educational psychology, etc.)

That means you are required to take 10semester units of elective courses to meet LLU's minimum requirement of 180-quarter units to award a Bachelor's Degree.
