- Tuition for the 2016-2017 school year is \$466/unit and is based on 63 BSHA program units.
 Program courses can be taken over five or eight quarters, depending upon the student's eligibility upon acceptance.
- The tuition estimates do NOT include any GE, elective, or professional coursework.
- The LiveText fee is a one-time assessment fee billed only the first quarter of student enrollment.
- University fees for the 2016-2017 school year are \$973/quarter and include parking, on-campus computer usage, library use, malpractice insurance, student health insurance, student services, fitness membership, and graduation fees.
 - Please Note: The BSHA program is a completely online degree; therefore students will not be charged the aforementioned university fees. However, because students will not be charged, they will not have access to the items listed that the fee provides.
- The above estimate reflects an average cost for all items.

- Laptop computers with wireless capability and a broadband connection are required, and all students must have software compatible with the newest version of Microsoft Office. Additional recommended items such as a personal printer are not included in the estimate.
- For students to obtain financial aid to cover computer expenses, a request form must be filed with the Financial Aid office. Please contact the Financial Aid office for more details.
- A smartphone or personal digital assistant (PDA) is not required for the program. However, most students use them throughout various aspects of the program. Costs associated with smartphone/PDA usage are not included in the above and are the students' responsibility.
- Housing and living costs are based on the living allowance provided by financial aid for off-campus students. Those students who live in an on-campus dorm or living with parents will be allotted less per month for housing. Please contact the Financial Aid office for more information.
- Fees associated with background checks or fingerprinting is not covered by financial aid and are the student's responsibility.
- Dues for national and local Professional organizations are not included in the estimate.
