- Tuition is currently \$444/unit.
- **The Emphasis is based on 24 units. Please note; some emphases are as low as 12 units or as high as 24 units. Some students may have already completed their emphasis. Check with the Program Director for details. Clinical based emphasis such as CT, MRI, Nuclear Medicine, Radiation Therapy, Cardiovascular, and Ultrasound have varying tuition rates and fees. Please check with each emphasis program site for tuition details.
- The tuition estimates do NOT include any GE, elective, or professional coursework.
- University fees are \$738/quarter and include parking, on-campus computer usage (printing fee not included), library use, malpractice insurance, student health insurance, student services, fitness membership, and graduation fees.
 - University fees are only charged to students within a clinical emphases
 - Please Note: Completely online students (non-clinical emphases) will not be charged the fee.

- Recommended equipment such as a home computer with internet access and a printer are not included in the estimate. A smartphone or tablet is not required for the program but most students use them throughout various aspects of the program. Costs associated with smartphone/ tablet usage are not included in the above.
- Clothing expenses are not included in the budget. The dress code for the program requires students to wear scrubs or business casual clothing during both the preclinical and clinical years. Students often add these expenses to their personal budget before arriving on campus.
- Dues for national and local Imaging organizations are not included in the estimate, though membership in is highly encouraged by the program.
- For financial aid purposes, the school year runs from Summer through Spring. Thus, each student will apply for financial aid a total of 3 times.
- **All expenses including tuition and fees are subject to change.**
