CEPT Program-Related Expenses/Student Budget

The table below is a budget cost sheet according to current tuition and fees for Loma Linda University. Costs for all expenses below are in accordance with current financial aid estimates for the 2014-2015 academic year. Please note that **all expenses including tuition and fees are subject to change.**

Notes:

- Tuition for the 2015-2016 academic year is \$428/unit. For students in the CEPT program, tuition is calculated according to block system, resulting in lowest estimate of numbers above (54 credit units for the school year). Should a student need to take additional coursework, such as AS students, the amount will be estimated higher based on the number of credit units taken outside of the normal block schedule of 61 units for the school year). The higher estimate of that range is based on 61 units for the school year. Please refer to CEPT credit unit breakdown on the CEPT Course Schedule page.
- University fees for the 2015-2016 school year are \$768/quarter and cover misc on campus fees.
- LiveText (\$75 one-time assessment fee billed during 1st quarter)
- The miscellaneous expenses are completely an estimate and can vary from student to student based on personal needs and distance from EP clinical site.
- Supplies and equipment include suggested items such as scrubs, professional attire & calipers.
- Laptop computers with wireless capability and broadband connection are required, especially for online coursework. All students must have software compatible with the newest version of Microsoft Office. Additional recommended items, such as a printer, are not included in the estimate.
- Fees associated with background checks are not covered by financial aid.
- Professional fees after graduation are not included in the table above. Certification exam through CCI (RCES certification) is \$350. IBHRE (CEPS certification) can range from to \$850-\$1000 based on membership and timing of applicant in scheduling exam.
