	Applicants must hold one of the following degrees before entering the program:	
	 Any Associate's degree (Science area preferred) from an accredited higher education institution 	
	 Any Bachelor's degree (Science area preferred) from an accredited higher education institution. 	
	Be a graduate of an accredited allied health program, including nursing (two-year, LVN, registered nurse)	
	Anatomy and Physiology, two-part sequence with labs (AHCJ 250 and AHCJ 251 are available at LLU as	
	an evening class).	
	Medical Terminology (can be taken as an online class at another accredited junior college)	
	Intro to Physics (available at LLU as an evening class).	
	College Algebra Can have a higher level class, such as Calculus.	
	Patient Care Methods (can be taken before entering the program at LLU the Summer prior to starting the	
	program.)	
	CPR- All students are required to have a current Health Care Provider CPR Card offered by the American	
	Heart Association upon admission into the program. Students must maintain certification for the entire	
	length of the program. (available at LLU as a day class)	
	For Cardiac Track Only- BART course through ABC Educators (or an approved equiv. course.) Contact
