Prerequisites for Admission to MOT Program  
For entry to 2017-2018 school year**

The prerequisites for admission to the MOT program are listed below. Prerequisites must be taken from regionally accredited colleges or universities, and must be completed no later than December prior to our June start date.

<b>Prerequisites</b>
Proof of completion of <b>B.A. or B.S. degree</b> in another field from a regionally accredited college or University, with a minimum GPA of 3.20.
<b>Human Anatomy with lab</b> (Courses taken older than 5 years at time of application will not be accepted)
<b>Human Physiology, with lab</b> (Courses taken older than 5 years at time of application will not be accepted)
<b>Statistics</b> (Courses taken older than 5 years at time of application will not be accepted)
<b>Human Lifespan Development</b> (Must cover life cycle from birth to death)
<b>Medical Terminology</b> (We will accept some online CE courses; please check with our department first for approval)

<b>Observation/Volunteer Experience:</b>
<b>40 hours</b> minimum, of observation in occupational therapy settings. Documentation of observation must be submitted prior to admission consideration.
