<u>COMMUNICATION SCIENCES & DISORDERS MS</u> - Admission to the program requires a bachelor's degree in Communication Disorders (also called Speech-Language Pathology). **Note: students admitted to the graduate program must show evidence of having completed a minimum of one undergraduate course in each of the following areas: biological sciences (such as biology, human anatomy, etc.), physical sciences (physics or chemistry preferred), statistics, and the social/behavioral sciences (such as psychology, sociology, educational psychology, etc.)
