Proof of completion of a **B.A. or B.S. degree** in any field from a regionally accredited college or university, with a minimum GPA of 3.2.

**Courses older than 5 years at the time of application will not be accepted.*

- A grade of B and above are required for all prerequisite courses. Grades below a B- will not be accepted. We do not require the GRE.
- Prerequisites must be taken from a regionally accredited college or university, and must be completed by the end of the Fall term (December 2021) prior to our June start date.

Observation/Volunteer Experience

40 hours minimum of observation in an occupational therapy setting. Documentation of observation must be submitted on OTCAS.
