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TRANSITIONAL MS - Admission to the program requires a bachelor's degree from an accredited college/university. Additional prerequisite coursework, beyond the bachelor's degree, is not required prior to entering this program. Students admitted to the Transitional Masters program must show evidence of having completed a minimum of one undergraduate course in each of the following content areas prior to fall quarter of their second year in the program: biological sciences (such as biology, human anatomy, etc.), physical sciences (physics or chemistry required), statistics, and the social/behavioral sciences (such as psychology, sociology, educational psychology, etc.).

COMMUNICATION SCIENCES & DISORDERS MS - Admission to the program requires a bachelor's degree in Communication Disorders (also called Speech-Language Pathology). ****Note:** students admitted to the graduate program must show evidence of having completed a minimum of one undergraduate course in each of the following content areas: biological sciences (such as biology, human anatomy, etc.), physical sciences (physics or chemistry required), statistics, and the social/behavioral sciences (such as psychology, sociology, educational psychology, etc.)
