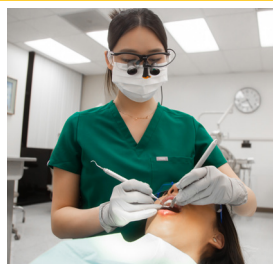

HEALTH SCIENCE, A.S.

The A.S. degree in Health Science at Loma Linda University is an on-campus, two-year college degree designed to prepare first-year, first-time freshman students for entry into various healthcare related baccalaureate-level educational programs offered by LLU. For students subsequently accepted into one of the career-track programs, the curriculum for the A.S. degree prepares them with prerequisite coursework, including both program prerequisite courses and many of the general education (GE) courses required to complete a Bachelor of Science degree in Dental Hygiene or Nursing. For students who are undecided on a specific area of interest, knowledgeable career advisors are available to help weigh available options.

- **Comprehensive Curriculum:** Our program includes a balanced mix of general education and core healthcare science courses. You will study English, history, psychology, and humanities, along with essential healthcare subjects like anatomy and physiology, chemistry, and microbiology.
- **Time-Saving Program Pathway:** Complete your degree in just 20 months with our in-person classes, designed for full-time freshmen eager to jump-start their education.
- **Preferred Admission Status:** Select programs will offer preferential admission consideration to graduates of this program who meet minimum requirements.

APPLICATION TIMELINE:

Applications to the A.S. degree in Health Science are accepted between September 1st and August 31st. Early submission of application is recommended. No application fee.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

In addition to [Loma Linda University](#) and [School of Allied Health Professions](#) admissions requirements, the applicant must produce the following:

- Grade Point Average (GPA) Minimum: 2.5
- Holding a high school diploma or equivalent
- Complete the LLU application, values and personal essays
- Three letters of recommendation that indicate your level of academic and/or professional background
