ESSAY	Each applicant is required to submit an online application, and within the application are ethics-based questions, and a 300-500 word essay. The essay is to include the following: why you chose medical sonography as a profession, why you have chosen to attend Loma Linda University, what you have done for service activity in your life, what your goals are in the next five years, and why you see yourself as a sonographer. Essays will be judged based on the inclusion of all of this content.
