

The “Voucher System”

The faculty at Loma Linda University understands that changes in the healthcare arena and in public school regulations have put a much greater demand on professionals than in the past. We realize that supervising students can take a great deal of your valuable time. To express our appreciation, and to help you meet the required CEU hours for state licensure, the Communication Sciences and Disorders offers a “Voucher System.” For each student clinician you supervise, you will be issued one voucher at the end of the quarter in which you supervised. One voucher can be redeemed for any of the following:

- 1) *Annual Alumni Homecoming Program*
 - CEU: Varies-1 voucher=3 hours
 - When: The first weekend of May (watch for email notification and mailed brochures)
 - What: Workshops led by guest speakers

- 2) *Other workshops offered by our department.*
 - CEU Symposium: Varies
 - When: Usually May or June (watch for email notification and mailed brochures)
 - What: Topic is usually related to supervision

- 3) *Open Seminar (CMSD 687) course at Loma Linda University*
 - CEU: 6 hours for CEU (1 unit of university credit may be earned, but tuition must be paid)
 - When: 1 evening/week for 3 consecutive weeks, offered each Summer and Fall quarter.
 - What: Seminars rotate, but may include Autism, AAC, Right Hemisphere Disorder, Treatment of Patients with Tracheostomy and Ventilator Dependency, etc.
