Statistics

(Courses taken older than 5 years at time of application will not be accepted)

Human Lifespan Development

(Must cover life cycle from birth to death)

Medical Terminology

(We will accept some online CE courses; please check with our department first for approval)

Observation/Volunteer Experience:

40 hours minimum, of observation in occupational therapy settings. Documentation of observation must be submitted prior to admission consideration. Grades B and above are preferable. Grades below B- will not be accepted. We do not require the GRE.
